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Sinner Paris is playing host to the photographer Cédric Roulliat from 9th February to 9th March 2023 for his exhibition entitled “POLYAMIDE COMMANDO”.

Through his photographs, this self-taught artist portrays an anachronistic celebration of a fantasy Kodachrome. “POLYAMIDE COMMANDO” presents a gallery of highly colourful antinaturalist characters, filled with desire or doubt, whose common denominator is their attachment to late-70s clothing made from synthetic materials.

In this exhibition, Cédric Roulliat displays twenty or so photos, all influenced by different worlds, from cinema to photo-romance and comics.

About Cédric Roulliat

Cédric Roulliat is a photographer and director.

Having focused initially on comic strips, he gradually turned towards the still and moving image to bring his work closer to other popular narrative forms, such as the cinema and photo-romance, in the aim of bringing characters to life and giving a glimpse of “moments in stories”.

In his pictures, the locations take a central position, with the setting itself acting as a protagonist, dictating the drama and graphic line to come.

As for the actors and actresses appearing in his vignettes, they embody recurring illustrations of desire, solitude or madness, in a mix of Hollywood, “*Nous Deux*” and a film from the 80s that could be by Brian de Palma or Guy Bourdin if he’d been a movie-maker.
