FOURTH EDITION OF THE EVOK AWARD

A shortlist of 6 titles is selected in March. This year, the jury will gather for an initial meeting on 12th April, before deliberating and announcing the winner on 6th June. The awards ceremony will take place on 14th June at the Brach.
