Twenty women, including writers, directors, journalists, poets and performers, all determined to bring desire and pleasure back to the heart of the feminist debate.

For *Hold-Up 21*, each author worked with Abigaïl Auperin to co-create the artworks, creating a sensual journey and using their poses to illustrate their stories.

Through her photographs, Abigaïl Auperin tells a story. Her inspiration can come from any source, as long as it is narrative, whether it be a great historical painting, a comic strip, an arthouse or genre film. The stories she invents are told in series, sometimes over several years, and are an ode to desire. But nothing – or very little – is actually shown because beyond the narrative what fascinates her is a representation of reality, the absent presence that can be found in both fashion photography and spirit photography. Her photographic stories are dominated by what happens out of frame and by a sense of timelessness. Meticulously planned using detailed storyboards, her scenes recreate the fascinating art of the diorama on the screen, in the frame or on the page.
