Eric Chacour awarded the Evok Collection 2024 Literary Prize

The 2024 winner is Éric Chacour for his book "**Ce que je sais de toi**", published by Éditions Philippe Rey.

With the support of Tristane Banon, Emmanuelle de Boysson and Anne-Marie Revol, who are responsible for the selection process, the Evok Collection Literary Prize is unique in terms of the infectious energy it generates and the diversity of its panel of judges. Every year, it celebrates the book that will be the perfect summer read: a French novel or a collection of short stories with obvious literary merit, reflecting the summer's very special spirit.

The award consists of €1500, a night in each of Evok's Parisian establishments, a jeroboam of Deutz champagne and other surprises. Evok will buy 200 copies of the winning book and place them in each of its hotel rooms with a banner that says "Evok Literary Prize".



"Ce que je sais de toi" (What I Know About You) is a debut novel, compelling thanks to its polished writing and its twists and turns. In 1980s Cairo, a young doctor, Tarek, feels trapped in his well-ordered life. Between his demanding job and a suffocating family, he has found respite by opening a clinic in the poor district of Moqattam. There, he befriends Ali, a local resident, who challenges his convictions and transforms his life.

This novel, brimming with humour and sensitivity, plunges the reader into the Levantine community of a changing Cairo, from the reign of Nasser to the 2000s. Through skilful narration, the author reveals the secrets of a fractured clan and Tarek's moving quest in search of the truth.
